



— CONSENT-GATED IDENTITY

GovPass.

A trusted identity journey that lets citizens approve what a service receives, verify with confidence and sign important actions without giving away their biometrics.

CONSENTED

The citizen sees the relying service and the stated request before authentication.

SCOPED

Services receive the approved verification result, not biometric data.

AUDITABLE

Each request, approval, verification and signature has accountable evidence.

A TRUSTED ANSWER, NOT A DATA HAND-OFF

Identity verification that is explicit, minimal and useful.

GovPass creates a controlled hand-off between a citizen and the bank, telco, benefits agency or public service they are using. The relying service asks for a defined outcome; the citizen sees and approves that request; GovPass returns only the allowed result.

01

Named consent

The request names the service, the purpose and the identity check before the citizen is redirected into the trusted journey.

02

Government-grade verification

Authentication happens inside the GovPass flow. The relying party does not embed capture or receive a biometric image or template.

03

Scoped response

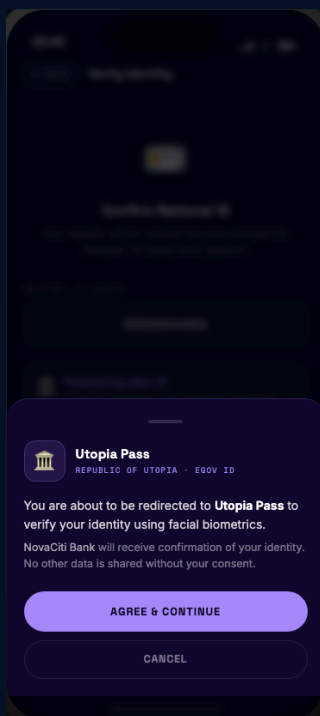
The service receives a signed, time-bound verification response and only the approved attributes or claims.

A citizen should never have to guess who is asking for their identity, why they need it or what will be shared.

THE CITIZEN SEES THE REQUEST BEFORE THE PLATFORM ACTS

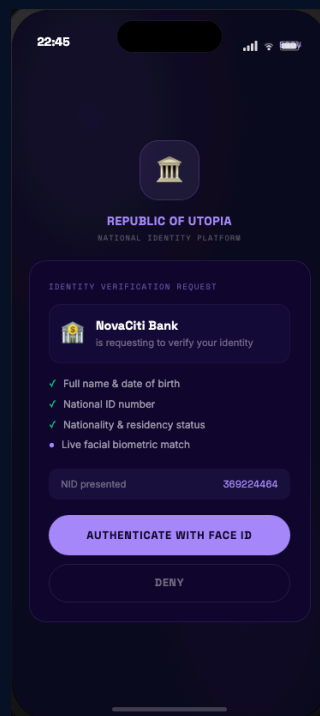
Consent, verification and signing are visible moments in the journey.

The GovPass pattern works across public services and regulated relying parties. The interface gives the citizen clarity; the platform preserves the policy, assurance and evidence behind it.



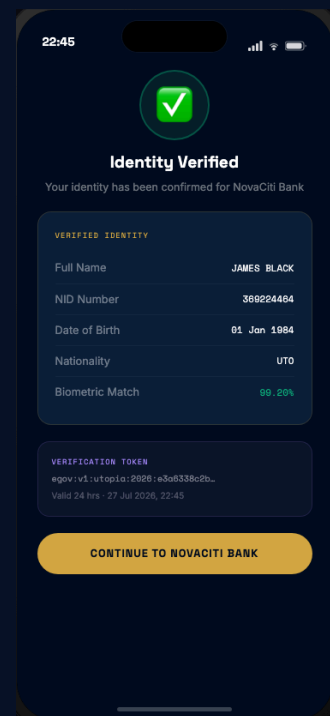
CONSENT

The relying app states the identity action before redirect.



ITEMISED REQUEST

The trusted flow shows the facts that will be checked.



SCOPED RESULT

The app receives confirmed claims and a verification token.



03 · HIGH-ASSURANCE ACTIONS

When the decision matters, make the signature a separate, visible act.

Programme controls

- 01 Define approved relying parties, requests and attribute-release policy.
- 02 Apply assurance and step-up rules appropriate to each journey.
- 03 Retain evidence for consent, verification, signing, recovery and audit.

GovPass brings together the citizen experience, consent model, verification response, signing path and operations required to make trusted identity useful at national scale.
